


PCA National Upcoming Events



While the rest of us had lunch, Brett Holbrook took advantage of the gaming opportunity by winning \$150 on the penny slots during our short visit.


Those that could took advantage of the perfect weather by lowering their convertible tops and taking maximum advantage of the beautiful drive from the Sierra foothills to its peaks.



This October, Diablo Region will hold its annual election to fill four (4) Board of Directors (BOD) vacancies for terms starting January 1st, 2023 (and ending December 31, 2024).

What does the BOD do?

The Board, composed of seven (7) active region members, is responsible for the proper conduct of the administrative affairs of the Diablo Region, the proper functioning of the various committees, and compliance with the Region Bylaws.
