Friday, September 7, 2012



As I write (well, type), we already have more than 20 people signed up for Thunderhill in October and over 30 for Mazda Laguna Seca in November. We are now wait-listing the beginner group at Laguna Seca (although a few places may yet open up, should we have cancellations or an unusually large team of instructors, so if you have not yet registered, go ahead - there still may be a good chance of getting in).

Thunderhill is also filling nicely and overall it looks like we will have a great turnout at both events. Don't forget, Diablo limits the number of cars at our track events to 60, to keep them fun, friendly, relaxed and safe. So don't procrastinate if you want to take part. Sign-up via www.motorsportreg.com

Directly following our event at Laguna Seca on 19th November, GGR have their two days (20th & 21st), so you could run three consecutive days with PCA Clubs if you wish...

I'm often asked about car preparation for the track. So here's how it works:

- 1. You don't need any special mods to join an HPDE (high performance driving event) at the track. (You don't need special belts, or seats, or wheels or tires). Of course, your car should be in good condition and have plenty of life left in the things that wear out like tires and brake pads. Plus, things like brake lights must work. Common sense stuff...as I know we all want to be safe.
- 2. You are 100% responsible for making sure your car is safe to run on the track, no-one else. The Tech Form you sign certifies this. If you are in any doubt, go to a shop or dealership and ask them to check it out if you had a recent maintenance service, you will have had this done anyway. If you keep to the usual schedule with annual maintenance on your car, you are probably most of the way there if you do a small mileage. If you have any concerns about your car, get it checked out. There's nothing worse than going to a track event wondering whether your car has a problem.
- Close to our track events, a couple of our sponsors usually offer free inspections for Diablo members. You do not have to get your car inspected at these to run with Diablo. But, if you have not had an inspection done recently, it's a good option.

Do visual checks anyway...take a good regular look at the obvious things – like tires, it's not just the tread depth and to make sure you haven't picked up a nail, it's also feeling around the back of the tire to make sure there are no bulges

If you do a low mileage in your Porsche, bear in mind that rubber based things like tires and belts deteriorate with age. Tires must not be over 6 years old to run on track, the compound hardens and can crack. We have had situations where someone has bought a low-mileage used car, only to find that the tires are too old to run on-track.






We had reserved tables and an express ordering line for some fresh, yummy fish. This restaurant has been on television and is well known for its HUGE menu of fish dishes.




