





I decided it was probably best to take a driver's education class before I crashed or killed myself. Where better to learn than at a DE event through Diablo PCA? To gauge my skill level, my instructor asked me how long I had owned the car...7 months; have you driven on a track?...Nope; have you been to a track?...Nope, have you ever driven fast?....Not Really, OKAYYYYY, there's a first time for everything! The instructor knew right then and there, it was going to be a very loooong day! The fastest, most adrenaline pumping driving I have every done...and did I forget to say SAFE too. After that first day, I was hooked!

As all the prior owners predicted, after 2 years, I was ready for a faster car (my husband on the other hand was looking for a faster car after my first DE event at Thunderhill-he knew what was coming). From everything I read, I knew a Cayman with its mid-engine was the best track car for me. We saw a bright green 2008 Cayman S Sport during Parade Week last year at Laguna Seca and I was smitten. That one wasn't for sale so we began seriously looking for another one.

Early last November an orange Cayman S Sport showed up on eBay: Sport Chrono Package, power sport seats, sport exhaust, PASM – all optioned out for the track – 303 hp, 0-60 in 5 seconds, and only 25,000 miles on the odometer. In 2008, Porsche made only 700 Cayman S Sports and sold 200 of those to the USA. This car is number 471 of 700.

The eBay auction did not meet the reserve so when we tried to negotiate for the car, the owner told us that he was going to sell his car to CarMax in Irvine. When my husband called CarMax, he found out that they allow their top sales people to drive any car they desire for up to 2 months before the car is available for public sale. A CarMax employee had already taken the Cayman. Not knowing when the employee would return the car, we watched the CarMax website non-stop, all day, every day for over two weeks until the day after Thanksgiving when we saw the car advertised on their website. Within an hour of its posting we had reserved the car and had it transferred to CarMax Modesto. The process was frustrating at times, but in the end it was well worth the effort.

Now this is the car I will own for a long time!

Seventy Years Behind the Wheel

Nobody is going to keep and drive a Porsche for 34 years without really loving their special old car. We did a pretty thorough restoration on our old 911SC three years ago and it found itself in the Laguna Seca Rennsport Reunion Display for 911's representing the year 1980. There is some merit in having been born in a



year when there were over a hundred car manufactured and then being able to witness the development of the motorcar to its remarkable present state of power and design. Sure it would be great to own a new Porsche of any model, but it is most enjoyable to own a wonderful old 911 that is very reliable, fun to drive and will keep up with most cars on the road.

However, to read the April Issue of this quality newsletter edited by Kay Maloy and see that 3 out of 10 new and transfer in members are driving new 2015 Porsche 911GT3's is pretty cool. Ed Won has set an amazing precedent with his purchase of a GT3, while our region President. What if our next Pres. were to buy a 918? Fortunately Brian already has one of the most desirable Porsches available and for some of us, it is almost affordable. Speaking of Caymans, and I just did, if you have not read the road test of the GT-4 in the June issue and on the cover of Road & Track, you owe it to yourself. At the present time, the entire production appears unfortunately, sold out before the first GT-4 is delivered to a customer.

I couldn't imagine a time that I had enough extra cash to keep one of our earlier sports cars while considering buying a newer one or another one that we always wanted. One of my buddies in the old Highland Touring Club was Charlie Holloman, who happened to be one of the Bay Area's first Computer Geeks and he worked for AT&T who appreciated his talents. Charlie owned a Mercedes 300SL at the same time Jan and I had the first AC ACE in Northern Calif. The year was 1957 and Charlie and I would, on occasion, trade cars and follow one another around some of our still existing rally or tour roads.

The 300SL was fun to drive on the highway as it would smooth out at any allowable speed and some that were not allowable. However, around town it was a beast to drive without power steering. Charlie liked his 300SL so much he decided to buy another one. This time it was a 300SL Cabriolet. A few months later, he offered me the gull wing for, a hard to believe these days--\$3,000. At that time, I still had the AC and could not afford an extra thousand dollars, let alone three thousand and we already had two cars in our garage. We all know what Gull Wings are going for now, so any excuse I had for not buying it is not worth much. I'm sure most of us could tell a few stories about the cars we should have bought or the ones we practically gave away.

Getting back to the 300SL. Jan and I left the church in Berkeley leading 30 or more mostly British cars to our reception in Oakland. We were riding in the back seat of Ken and Grace Wilson's 300B Mercedes Sedan, same engine, but carbs instead of fuel injection, four on the column and not even one gull wing door. Unknown to us, another 300B had been purchased about the same time as Ken's by Ransom Cook, the President of Wells Fargo Bank, for his wife. Three years later his wife passed away and the 300B was acquired by another HTC buddy of mine, Bob Potter the owner of Grand Prix Motors on Piedmont Avenue in Oakland. Before I knew it, the 300B was in our garage in Hayward along with the ACE.

Jan and I really loved our AC with its 1923 fire pump engine: 2 liter, overhead cam, 6 cylinder with 3 SU side draft carburetors. Shortly after it was available in 1956, AC acquired the rights to install the Bristol 2 liter double overhead cam engine that produced another 20 HP for a total of 120. However, our car with its longer stroke and smaller diameter cylinders had more low speed torque than the Bristol Engine, allowing me to beat them in most auto crosses, unless there were very long straights.

I was also able to get a lot of track time in with the AC because while we owned it I happened to be Chief Turn Marshal for the San Francisco Region of SCCA. In addition to it being used as a course car, one of the best times in it was spent at Laguna Seca leading the modified cars around the course for 15 laps, while attempting to break up the fog. I spent the whole time going almost flat out, while these big bore cars were chomping at my heels. We also were fairly successful with Concours D'elegance, managing a number of 1st and a 3rd at Pebble Beach.

We might still have the AC except our daughter count went from 1 to 3 over a five year period and our sports car was replaced by a Morgan Plus 4, four seater. There were belts for the two front bucket seats, but the back bench type seat had none. I installed three sets of lap belts where there was only room for 2 adults. Although the girls were very young, they really enjoyed the ride. The Marin County Morgan Club at that time was called the Abington Rough Riders because, you guessed it, the ride was so rough. Less than five minutes on the freeway and all three girls would be sound asleep.
