This year a Porsche RS Spyder won the LMP2 class at Le Mans, easily out-distancing the nearest competition. But along with many of you, I had hoped that the factory would have returned to the highest levels of motorsport by now. Sadly, this seems less likely than ever given the twists in Porsche's plans for a leveraged takeover of Volkswagen AG. Quite something to think that 75 years ago (as of June 22nd) Professor Ferdinand Porsche received approval from the German government to build a prototype of the Volkswagen Beetle, and marvel at how many millions of cars and billions of dollars/euros have followed.

Let me take a moment to thank everybody that came out for the Diablo Mille tour on June 20th, and Tito Young who organized the event for a second year in a row. By a rough count of cars and the waiver signatures afterward, we had 35 cars and 68 people enjoying a wonderful drive through Marin County and up the coast to Bodega Bay. I was especially pleased to see folks bringing their kids along for this family-friendly event. And while it was challenging keeping so many cars together, it appears that we managed to share the road with the other drivers and bicyclists without incident or complaint.

This is my last chance to remind you all to get ready for our 25th anniversary celebration, coming up fast on July 18th. We've got a great venue and a number of special features coming together for this notable event. I want to take a mo-

Looking a little farther down the road, the traveling breakfast program will swing to the South on July 25th. 
J.D. Power Quality Study: Porsche Receives Quality Award

Stuttgart - 23 June 2009. The vehicles of the Dr. Ing. h.c. F. Porsche AG, Stuttgart, continue to meet the highest quality standards in the USA, the largest export market for the Stuttgart sports car manufacturer. The US market research institute J.D. Power arrived at this conclusion in its latest survey, "Initial Quality Study," which was published yesterday. Porsche reached second place after Lexus, and is thereby also the best European manufacturer.

With the prestigious brand evaluation, Porsche has now reached a top position on four consecutive occasions; in the years 2006 to 2008, the Stuttgart manufacturer of sporty, premium vehicles has held first place. Frank Tuch, head of Company Quality at Porsche, said: "Three first and a second place in the brand evaluation of the noted J.D. Power Initial Quality Study, in the last four years, are the result of consistent quality work and customer focus during development, in production and in sales. The award demonstrates that our sustainability strategy has paid off. The challenge is not to achieve high-quality standards on short notice, but rather to sustain these over the course of years. There is hard work behind this. The high degree of satisfaction of the Porsche customers is a reflection of the new car quality."

J.D. Power reviewed the satisfaction of new car buyers, in the first 90 days after delivery of the vehicles. Based upon a catalog containing a total of 228 criteria, nearly 81,000 customers were asked about their impressions concerning quality and workmanship.



Wow, it is so great to have a dealer that is so supportive and treat us so nicely.





Porsche Presents "The Porsche Way"

Stuttgart. Dr. Ing. h.c. F. Porsche AG, Stuttgart, is proudly presenting its history "in motion": In a 2 ½-film "The Porsche Way", the Company presents its entire history from the early years up to the present day on one full-coverage DVD. Starting with the lifetime achievements of Ferdinand and Ferry Porsche, the film focuses in eight chapters on the development of the famous sports car manufacturer, proceeding from one decade to the next. "This is the first time that a car maker is presented so exhaustively on a DVD", says Dieter Landenberger, the Director of the Porsche Archives.

The DVD is based on the Archives Collection with more than 5,000 hours of footage. Taking most impressive scenes from the history of the Company, the products and motorsport, the DVD presents numerous film extracts never seen before. Several outstanding celebrities of former times also make an appearance in the film, among them former racing drivers such as Hans Herrmann, Eberhard Mahle, and Paul Ernst Strähle as well as former employees of Porsche such as the "Engine King" Hans Mezger or Dr. Heinz Rabe, formerly the Director of the Porsche Social Affairs Department. As a further highlight, the film comes with music composed specifically for this DVD.

"The Porsche Way" from the Porsche Museum Edition is now available in German and English at the Porsche Museum Shop at a price of Euro 24.90.







Yahoo Mail, Diablo Messages, and the Spam Folder

PCA National tells us that the email system they provide for regions to send messages to their members is having trouble with some spam filters. In particular, it appears that members who use Yahoo's free email system are having PCA messages sent to their spam folder.

There are a lot of free email providers on the Internet, but Diablo has at least 80 members who may be missing important messages as a result of this situation. This article describes how to find out if your Yahoo account is being affected by this, and something you can do to correct it. However if you use a different free web mail system there should be similar steps you can take to do the same thing.

Users of Yahoo Mail should access the system with their favorite web browser. Your inbox may look something like this, depending on whether you use the "new" or "classic" user interface:





Not a single Diablo message to be seen, but you've heard that something was sent out recently. Let's check the spam folder and see if it was sent there by Yahoo's spam filter. Just click on the Spam folder from the list on the left side of the page. A close-up showing where you should click appears to the left.

Once you've opened the Spam folder, you'll see a screen like the one below. Note the message from Diablo at the top of the list.

This is a very important message about events taking shape in our region. You will really want to make sure you receive and read this message in a timely manner. But what if your ISP thinks this message is spam? This is believed to be happening these days with users of the Yahoo! free mail service, so we'll start with them.

If you use Yahoo for your email, we're asking you to start by checking your spam folder to see if any messages from Diablo have been caught

Click the "Not Spam" button and the message will immediately be moved to your inbox. But this doesn't guarantee that Yahoo won't send future messages to the spam folder. You should be able to address that by creating a filter. To do that, open the Options menu in the top right as shown in the following screenshot.





