There was music, over 60 cars on display, awards, raffle prizes and lots of people strolling The Livery surveying the awesome rows of gorgeous metal beauties.


Even the weather cooperated and gave us a calm warm day to meet fellow Porsche owners and finalize the day with a free lunch at Luna Loca.


Tri-Valley Saturday Breakfast


