

### **Important Information**

Diablo Region Porschephiles,

Have you enjoyed a great tour? How about a social event or the exhilaration of driving your Porsche on the track? All of these and other great member benefits are all possible because of members that had an idea or wanted to contribute to enhancing the Porsche ownership experience. These events often take considerable planning and commitments to site holders or other vendors that are needed to support the events. In many instances, the Region must commit resources weeks if not months in advance. For example, the number of meals must be committed to 7 days before the Annual Picnic but only 40 people may be signed up on that date, but more than 80 people typically attend. Knowing this, and not wanting to turn members away, the Region has to make a financial commitment for the additional meals.

The Region often opens registration on Eventbrite or MSR multiple weeks before the event to allow for an accurate attendance projection when we make site commitments. To assist our Region members who are hosting events during 2016, the Region will institute an enrollment premium 7 days before the event enrollment closes. The date and amount of the enrollment premium will be described in the event announcement. We hope that this will facilitate timely sign-ups and avoid surcharges by our vendors to accommodate late enrollees.

The Region has a great list of activities planned for 2016 and wants to make hosting an event as seamless as possible so more members can participate. So take a look at the schedule, find an activity and sign up early. We hope to see you at an upcoming tour, track day or social gathering soon.

As a courtesy to event planners or tour leaders, please sign up by the indicated deadline.

Deposits are made in advance based on a specified number of participants, and if more signups occur, there will be penalty fees

#### SEVENTY-ONE YEARS BEHIND THE WHEEL

#### **AUTOBAHN ADVENTURE 9/30 to 10/10/2007**

Jan and I had been aware of Autobahn adventures for two or three years, and we both thought what a wonderful program, if we could afford it. Well, the 2007 Porsche Parade in



San Diego gave us an offer we couldn't refuse. Mark and Tina Trewartha, the event hosts, held a drawing in their booth at Parade and Jan won \$1500 off the price of her participation, and that made it impossible not to participate. Airfare was not included and we were able to get an Air Force flight from Travis AFB to Rammstein AFB, which was about 45 miles from our starting point, the Kempinski Hotel in Frankfurt. The Kempinski was one of eight marvelous hotels for both lodging and food on our trip. We even stayed at the Dorint Hotel, Nurburgring, where our first floor balcony room was a mere 100ft. from the Formula 1 Track, where six BMW drivers were competing with each other. The room had a guest book that contained many well-known drivers and car owners, while the halls, dining room, lobby and Hotel Museum contained everything from driver Mannequins to full size F 1 cars hanging from the ceiling. The only thing better than viewing these hotel features was our day spent as a passenger and driver on the Nurburgring.

All of us (14 couples) had been driving new black 911 Porsches that had less than 2000 miles. We had a 911S Coupe, while a couple of others had 4 wheel drives and a Cabriolet. All the Porsches were owned by Avis. Avis had bought them new from Porsche on the basis of renting them out for six months and then selling them back to Porsche. I have no idea how they were handled after that. Who knows, but it must be better than taking over a vehicle that had been leased for two or three years.

Maybe you're asking now if we drove the Porsches on the Ring? Here cooler heads prevailed and we were each assigned Rent A Race Cars that had their facility close to the Ring. I was assigned a Race Ready Volvo two door with some modification and a roll bar. Jan elected not to drive the Ring, but did six laps with our leader Mark in his Race Rental.

I forget which driver I paired up with, but he drove his three laps first while, I tried to remember which turns were coming up next. Jackie Stewart called The Ring, "Green Hell", not only for the green foliage, but the many banked concrete turns and it's long length. I have been lucky enough to drive all twenty of our Northern California courses along with some others outside the state like Road America; however, none of them tested your ability like the Ring.

When I got behind the wheel, I thought I was moving pretty good until I was passed by two Ferraris that made us feel like we were stopped. The strangest sensation though was being passed by two motorcycles that were ten feet above us on a steeply banked concrete turn. Even though the present F 1 course is not in the route we drove, it still has 14 miles of unforgiving turns.

As for some of the other great features of the event, each Porsche had a GPS that allowed us to set our hotel destination for that night in the morning. Autobahn destinations were not much of a problem, but secondary roads and getting through a strange, large city was a challenge in the States, let alone Germany and it's difficult long city words. At one point on the Autobahn, the GPS told us to take an off ramp and go into the hills. It didn't seem right at the time, but we decided to humor the lady with the lovely voice and drove 23 miles before back tracking to our point of departure. We were able to reach our destination and had no further problems with our GPS.

If you make it to the next Parade or any event where Mark and Tina have a booth, be sure to check it out. You won't find a nicer couple or a better way to part with some of your hard earned Porsche money.

### Collings Foundation's Wings of Freedom Flight Experience

Take a tour through living history - walk through a Boeing B-17 Flying Fortress and Consolidator B-24 Liberator and/or take a flight in the last flying B-24 Liberator.

The B-17 Flying Fortress is a high flying, long-range bomber used primarily by the US Army Air Force for daylight strategic bombing against German industrial and military targets. The bomber was used to achieve air superiority over Western Europe in preparation for the Invasion of France by allied forces. The B-17 played a lessor role in the War in the Pacific conducting raids against Japanese shipping and airfields.

The Collings Foundation's B-24 Liberator is the last flying B-24 that saw combat. An American heavy bomber used extensively in World War II saw action in the Western European Theater, Battle of the Atlantic, and bombing campaigns in the Pacific. The B-24 holds the distinction of being the most produced heavy bomber in history with almost 19,000 made, but only 1 remains flying today!

For the more adventurous, take a ride in the B-24. Walk through the bomb bay, sit in the tail gun turret, and for the real flexible, squeeze into the nose gun turret, or just stick your head out the waist gun windows while in flight. Take a ride and feel the experience!

If we have more than 10 people, we will reserve space in either the B-17's 5 pm flight or the B-24, 5:30 flight. If we do not fill an entire flight, we will have to wait until those spots are filled by other people.
